1. GiveIndia Foundation – Project Identification

Scope: Vivriti engaged with the NGO GiveIndia for their advisory services to identify the lake restoration project.

CSR Layout: INR 81,749/-

2. Project: Rajan Thangal Lake Restoration

Scope: In association with the Environmentalist Foundation of India (EFI), the Rajan Thangal lake restoration project will help in reviving 11.5 acres of the water body from the encroachment of invasive weeds that reduces its water retaining capacity. The intervention measures for the lake restoration involve de-weeding, de-silting, bund strengthening, border trenching, fencing and native tree plantation.

Timeline: 4-8 months CSR Layout: INR 42,85,274/-

3. IIT Madras (IITM) Incubation Cell – Contribution to IITM Projects

The IITM Incubation Cell extends support to the incubated start-ups through provision of services like mentorship, business support services, value additions, seed funding, and provision of office space and infrastructure. IITM engages with corporate and private partners to help in project funding through grants and donations, and for these charges 5-10% of the total project cost.
