1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited financial results of Vivriti Capital Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") for the quarter ended 31st December and year to date results for the period from 1st April 2025 to 31st December 2025, (the "statement") submitted by the company pursuant to regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations, 2015"). 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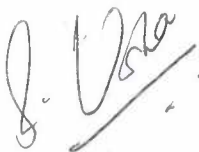

Notes to the unaudited standalone financial results for the quarter and year to date period ended 31 December 2025

- 1 Vivriti Capital Limited ("the Company") is a Middle Layer Non-Banking Financial Company (NBFC-ML), registered with the Reserve Bank of India ("the RBI").
- 2 The above unaudited standalone financial results for the quarter and year to date period ended 31 December 2025 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and subsequently approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on 11 February 2026. The above results for the quarter and year to date period ended 31 December 2025 have been reviewed by the statutory auditors of the Company. The auditors have issued an unmodified limited review report.
- 3 The unaudited standalone financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard ('Ind AS') 34 - "Interim Financial Reporting" as prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act'), and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 52 of the Securities Exchange Board of India ("SEBI") (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015. The financial results have been drawn up on the basis of Ind AS, that are applicable to the Company as at 31 December 2025. Any application guidance/ clarifications / directions issued by the RBI or other regulators are implemented as and when they are issued/ applicable.
- 4 There are no separate reportable segments in accordance with Ind AS 108 on "Operating Segments" in respect of the Company.
- 5 Other equity includes Statutory Reserves as per Section 45-IC of Reserve Bank of India Act 1934, balance in Securities Premium Account, Employee Stock Options Outstanding Account and Retained earnings comprising of reserves in statement of profit and loss and other comprehensive income.
- 6 In terms of the requirement as per RBI notifications no. - RBI/DOR/2025-26/359 DOR.ACC. REC. No.278/21 .04.018/2025-26 dated 28 November 2025 on implementation of Indian Accounting Standards, Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) are required to create an impairment reserve for any shortfall in impairment allowances under Ind AS 109 and Income recognition, Asset Classification and Provisioning (IRACP) Norms (including provision on standard assets). The impairment allowances under Ind AS 109 made by the Company exceeds the total provision required under IRACP (including standard asset provisioning) as at 31 December 2025 and accordingly, no amount is required to be transferred to impairment reserve.
- 7 Disclosures pursuant to RBI Notification - RBI/DOR/2025-26/359 DOR.ACC. REC. 8.8 The information related to Debt Service Coverage Ratio, Interest Service Coverage ratio, Current ratio, long term debt to working capital ratio, bad debts to accounts receivable ratio, current liability ratio, debtors turnover, inventory turnover and operating margin have not been included as these disclosures are not applicable to the Company considering the nature of business undertaken by the Company.

9 The Company does not have any listed non-convertible redeemable preference shares and accordingly disclosures under regulation 52(6) of the Securities Exchange Board of India ("SEBI") (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 are not applicable to the Company.

10 Pursuant to the notification of 4 New Labour Codes by Government of India viz the Code on Wages, 2019, Code on Social Security, 2020, the Industrial Relations Code, 2020 and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 collectively referred to as "The New Labour Codes" w.e.f. 21 November 2025, the Company has reassessed its employee benefit obligations based on the revised definition of wages and expanded eligibility criteria. The impact of these have resulted in an increase in Employee Benefit expenses by INR 164.90 Lakhs for the quarter and year to date period ended December 2025. The Company continues to monitor the developments and will review its estimates as further clarifications and Rules are notified.

11 On 27 June 2024, the Board of Directors of the Company has approved a scheme or arrangement, amongst Vivriti Capital Limited, Hari and Company Investments Madras Private Limited, Vivriti Next Limited, Vivriti Asset Management Private Limited and Vivriti Funds Private Limited and their respective shareholders under Sections 230 to 232 of the Companies Act, 2013 in conjunction with business combinations between the entities referred to herewith. The scheme inter-alia has been approved by the National Company Law Tribunal, Chennai bench vide order No. CP/CAA/37/2025 dated 9th December 2025 read with order No. IA/CA/256/2025 dated 19th December 2025. Certified to be true copies of such orders have been received by the Company on 2nd January 2026 and 2nd February 2026 respectively.

Pursuant to such order received, the Company shall within thirty days from the date of the receipt of such order cause a certified copy of the same to be delivered to the Registrar of Companies for registration. On such document being filed, the effective date of such scheme shall be identified as per the terms of Part I Section C Clause 13(f) of the aforementioned scheme of arrangement. The event however does not have any impact on the unaudited standalone financial results for the quarter and year to date period ended 31 December 2025.

12 All outstanding non-convertible listed debt securities are secured by way of an exclusive charge on identified receivables of the Company with security cover of 1.08 times of outstanding amount on such securities at any point in time. All outstanding non-convertible unlisted debt securities are secured by way of an exclusive charge on identified receivables of the Company with security cover of 1.11 times of outstanding amount on such securities at any point in time. There are no unsecured non-convertible securities.

The procedures performed vary in nature and timing from, and are less in extent than for, a reasonable assurance engagement. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed. Accordingly, we have performed the following procedures in relation to the Statement:
 - (a) Obtained and read the Debenture Trust Deed and the Information Memorandum in respect of the secured Debentures and noted the security cover percentage required to be maintained by the Company in respect of such Debentures, as indicated in Annexure I of the Statement.
 - (b) Traced and agreed the principal amount of the Debentures outstanding as on December 31, 2025, to the reviewed financial statement of the Company and unaudited books of account maintained by the Company as at December 31, 2025;

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- (c) Obtained and read the particulars of security cover required to be provided in respect of Debentures as indicated in the Debenture Trust Deed and the Information Memorandum.
- (d) Traced the value of assets indicated in Annexure I of the Statement to the unaudited financial result of the Company and unaudited books of account maintained by the Company as on December 31, 2025.
- (e) Obtained the list of security created in the register of charges maintained by the Company and 'Form No. CHG-9' filed with Ministry of Corporate Affairs. Traced the value of charge created against assets to the security cover.

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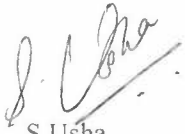
